



2026 Abstract Submission Terms and Conditions

The terms and conditions are listed below:

- 1. By submission of an abstract, the author(s) understand that:
 - while they retain ownership of copyright of their presentation, AHURI may publish their abstract, PowerPoint presentation and/or any biographical information in the conference pocket program, media releases, social media platforms and on the conference website, portal and/or app;
 - their presentation may be filmed and/or audio recorded and may be made available after the presentation and /or conference;
 - their final PowerPoint presentation will be collected prior to the conference and uploaded to the conference portal/app and to the conference website; and
 - should their final PowerPoint presentation change to what was provided prior to the conference the revised version will be collected and uploaded to the conference portal/app and website.
- 2. Acceptance is conditional on the speaker registering to attend the conference.
- 3. Speakers must register as a delegate by **19 April 2026 and have paid for their registration no later than 3 May 2026**.
- 4. Speakers will be provided a special registration rate that will be less than the Early Bird registration fee. Speakers will be sent a link to register upon acceptance of the invitation.
- 5. Speakers acknowledge that if they have not registered by 19 April and paid by 3 May 2026, AHURI may withdraw the invitation to present at the conference.
- 6. Speakers are responsible for their own travel, accommodation, and incidentals in respect to attending the conference.
- 7. If you are including an accompanying speaker with lived experience, please ensure you have read the following AHURI documents:

 - AHURI guidelines for Consumer and Lived Experience payment

If a Lived Experience speaker is not in a paid position at a relevant organisation, AHURI will provide them with complimentary registration. Payment, travel and accommodation costs for a speaker with Lived Experience remain the responsibility of the organisation including them in the abstract submission. Where this is not possible, the speaker/organisation may apply to AHURI for support to cover travel and accommodation expenses to enable them to attend - noting that there is no guarantee this will be provided and is subject to availability of funding.
